School Community Council

*The Utah state Legislature passed a law in 2000 requiring every public school in the state to establish a School Community Council at the school-site level (Utah Code. Section 53A-1a-108). Each School Community Council consists of the principal, school employees, and parents or guardians of students attending the school. The School Community Council determines their school's greatest academic need and prepares a plan to address that need with the school's portion of the money distributed from the School LAND Trust program.*

Are you interested in participating in our School Community Council? Members will learn about the services and programs offered at Kauri Sue as well as the curriculum and professional development opportunities for our teachers. Members help develop our School Improvement Plan and our School Land Trust budget. The Council also plans Teacher Appreciation throughout the year and the Teacher Appreciation luncheon each May. Everyone who is interested can become part of the committee. We are a unique school with fewer students than a traditional elementary school so we want involved parents to stay involved for as long as they wish and the state has agreed that it is not necessary for us to hold an election. We are glad to have your input and participation whether this is your first year or your seventh year. Meetings are held on Mondays in the main office conference room from 9:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. on the following dates: September 19<sup>th</sup>, November 14<sup>th</sup>, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, and March 20<sup>th</sup>.
